

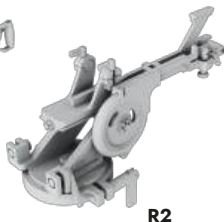
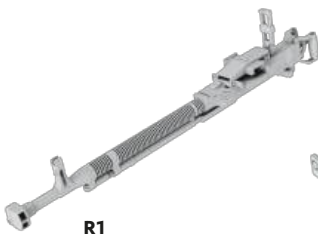


The DSHKM (Degtyaryov-Shpagin Large-Caliber Modernized) is a Soviet heavy machine gun developed based on the DSHKM (1938). It was designed for engaging lightly armored targets, aircraft, and providing fire support to infantry. The modernization, carried out in 1946 under the guidance of Vasily Shpagin, significantly improved the weapon's accuracy and reliability. The DSHKM was widely used during World War II and in the post-war period by many countries around the world.

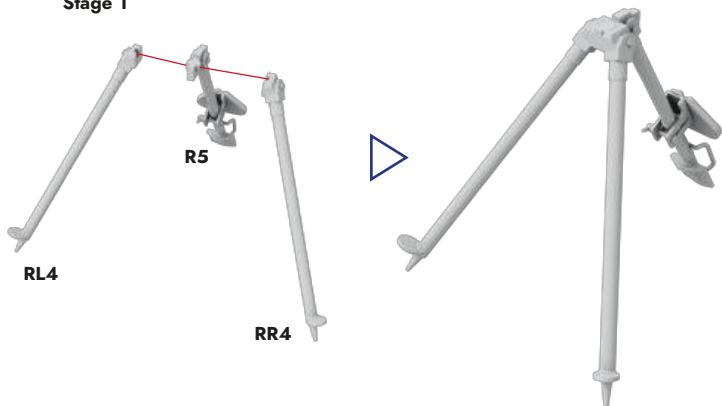

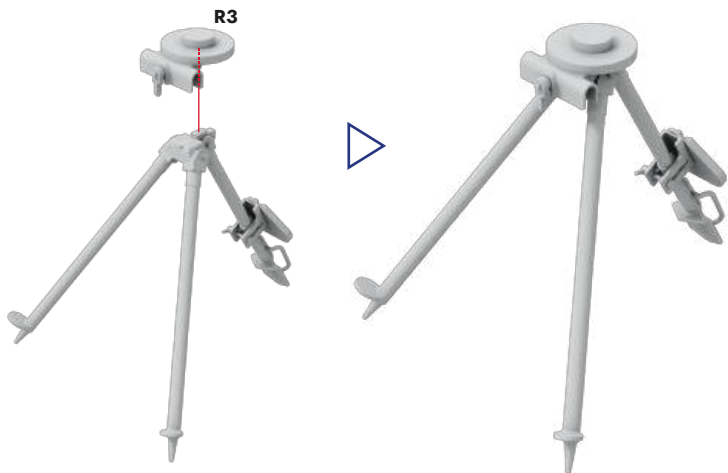
DETAILS AFTER REMOVAL FROM SUPPORTS



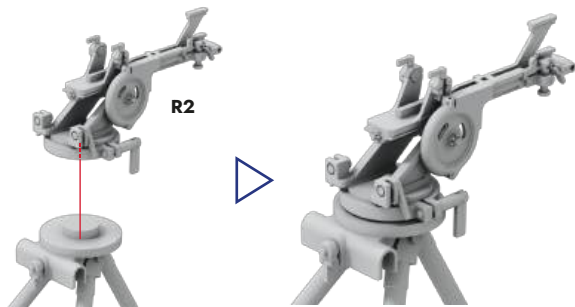

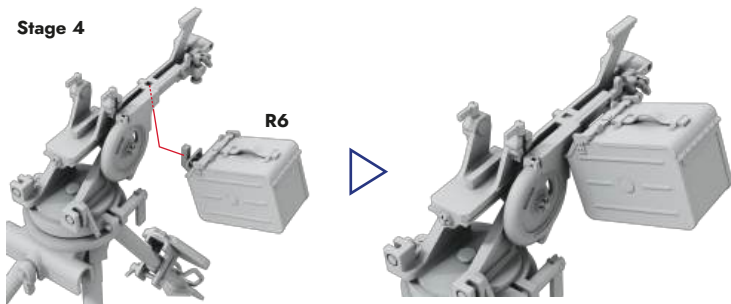
