



Mortar 2B9 "Vasylok" of one of the DShV brigades

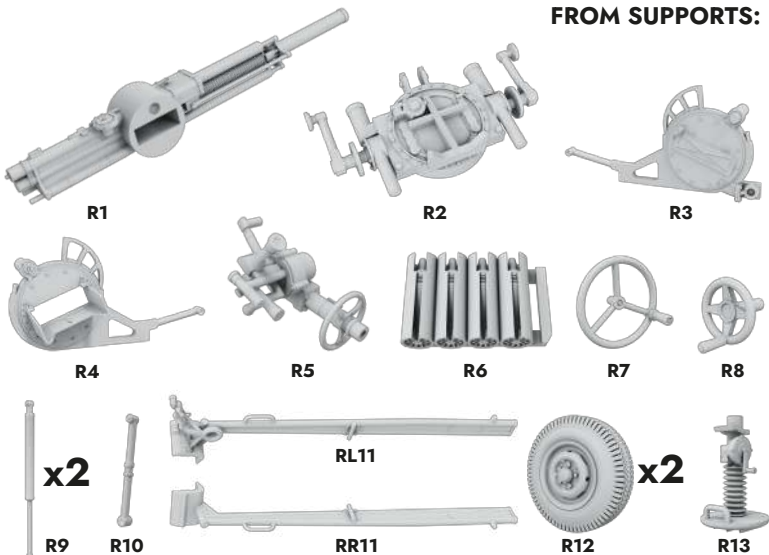
The 2B9M "Vasylok" is a Soviet 82mm automatic mortar developed in the 1970s as a modernized version of the 2B9 mortar. Its main feature is the ability to fire in automatic bursts, allowing for rapid suppression of targets. The mortar is mounted on a wheeled carriage, providing mobility and ease of transportation. The "Vasylok" has been used in numerous armed conflicts across the post-Soviet space. Since the beginning of

Russia's full-scale invasion in 2022, the 2B9M has been actively used by Ukraine's Defense Forces to support infantry and strike enemy positions.
