



The 120 mm 2B11 mortar is a Soviet artillery weapon developed in the 1980s as part of the 2S12 "Sani" mortar system. It succeeded the M-120 mortar, maintaining its firepower while featuring a lighter design and improved mobility. The 2B11 is intended for targeting enemy personnel, fortifications, and lightly armored vehicles at distances of up to 7 kilometers. It was widely used by the Soviet Armed Forces and later adopted by the militaries of post-Soviet states. Due to its effectiveness and ease of operation, the mortar remains in use to this day.

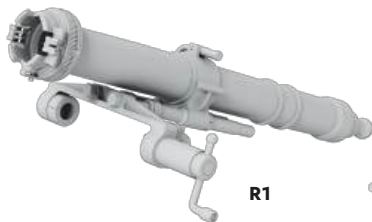

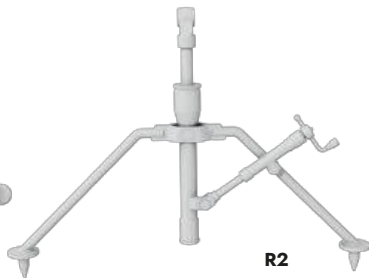
